Tychi Systems Announces Lever Version of the BioKnob(TM)

BioLever(TM) Conforms to ADA Requirements for Commercial Doors

SALEM, N.H.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Tychi Systems is shipping the **BioLever™** for those seeking a biometric lock with the features of the BioKnob but with levers to meet ADA (Disability Act) requirements. The BioLever retains the small footprint of the BioKnob and also comes in brass or silver colors.

Tychi Systems also announced a 100,000 sq.ft. expansion to their company-owned factory in Guangdong, China. The BioKnob and BioLever feature a thermal sensor and the smallest footprint for home and office doors. Tychi Systems is the only American company solely devoted to development and manufacturing of biometric locks. The company is located in Salem, NH, where it does final assembly, test and technical support for its locks. It set up its own manufacturing facility in China to better control its quality and protect its intellectual property, but all customer relationships and support is out of Salem, NH.

Tychi Systems door locks offer many advanced features, including recognition of up to 100 people by fingerprint, unlocking by either a fingerprint or individual passcode, five levels of security and recording of the last 1000 entries by ID, date and time. Mechanically, Tychi locks meet Grade 2 standards and can withstand outdoor weather and salt water spray.



Both the BioKnob and BioLever can be installed into the standard 2-1/8" hole and cutouts for US cylindrical latch door locks. They are stand-alone, battery-operated locks that require no external wiring or computer. The rechargeable, dual-channel battery system is good for a minimum of 1000 openings per charge, with warnings starting about 50 openings before recharging is needed.

Three hours of charge via an AC adapter will fully charge the batteries for another 1000 entries, typically good for six to nine months in a residence or secured office. Alternatively, the locks can be hardwired directly to AC power in which case the built-in batteries would provide back-up power.
